These industrial stack keys have been designed to help Hamiltonians call in concerns regarding visible air emissions from stacks in Hamilton’s industrial core.

What to look for:

If you see visible emissions coming from a stack (not steam but discolored discharges of a black, brown, green, yellow, or orangey-red colour), it is likely that the stack emission that you are viewing is exceeding provincial air quality regulations.

Who to contact:

If you see visible stack smoke, please take the time to call in the incident to the provincial Ministry of the Environment (MOE). Be prepared to indicate the following with regards to emission:

- Time of day
- Wind direction
- Discharging Stack (refer to key)
